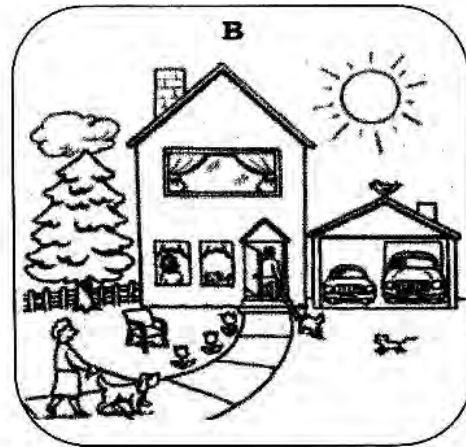
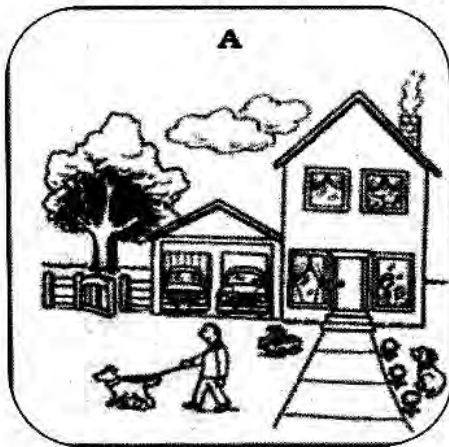

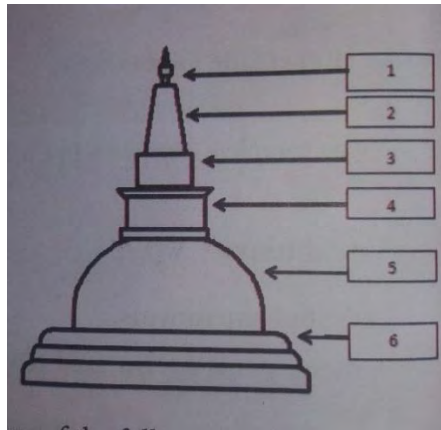

One of the most sacred Buddhist temples in Sri Lanka is the Kelaniya Raja Maha Viharaya, which stands majestically in the heart of Kelaniya , facing the Kelani river. It is only 11 km from Colombo. The annual perahara or the Duruthu perahara of the Kelaniya temple is held in January.

It is said, that Buddha's third visit to Sri Lanka was to Kelaniya, following an invitation by Naga King named Maniakkitha over 2500 years ago to settle a dispute between Chulodara and Mahodara over a gem studded chair. On his arrival King Maniakkitha offered the gem studded chair to Lord Buddha to preach Dhamma seated on it. Later King Maniakkitha constructed a dagaba or a pagada which has taken the shape of a heap of paddy, whereas, the other dagabas in Sri Lanka take the shape of a bell or a bubble. The gem studded chair is believed to be enshrined in this Dagaba.
